Each year, Kathy contributes her own time, money and talent to travel to each Warren RECC office to discuss the work of United Way in our local communities and the benefits of giving back.

Throughout Kathy's tenure as corporate giving coordinator, Warren RECC employee gifts have increased by over 70% for over \$700,000 in total contributions during that time. For each year from 2015-19, Warren RECC was recognized with a Top 10 Campaign Award, putting Warren RECC in a category with much larger companies such as Scott Murphy Daniel and Fruit of the Loom.

Over the last 10 years, Warren RECC has received 19 awards from United Way of Southern Kentucky, including four Leadership Investment Awards, two Greatest Giving Increase Awards and four Top Givers Awards.
