VACCINE UPDATE

As of April 12, all Kentuckians age 16 and over are eligible to sign up for a vaccine appointment. For information, including links to vaccination sites and free transportation options, click <u>here</u>.

Also on April 12, Governor Beshear announced that once 2.5 million Kentuckians have received at least one shot, he will lift statewide COVID-19 restrictions. Read more <u>here</u> and <u>here</u>.

HEALTHY AT WORK
